

Total Student Headcount License Quick Start

Overview

This guide describes how to install and activate a Total Student Headcount (TSH) license at your university. The TSH license allows students to install MathWorks software on their personally-owned computers.

This guide includes detailed instructions for both administrators and students.

Deployment of Total Student Headcount License

This deployment method allows all students to install MathWorks software on individual computers.

Summary of Steps:

1. The administrator retrieves the Activation Key and makes it available to students.
2. Students create a MathWorks Account and associate their accounts with the license using the Activation Key.
3. Students download, install, and activate the software.

Administrators: Retrieve Activation Key

1. Log into the **License Center**: mathworks.com/licensecenter
2. Select the Total Headcount license labeled **Student**.
3. Select the **Install and Activate** tab.
4. Click **Advanced Options** button to retrieve the **Activation Key**.
5. Provide the Activation Key to the students who need to use the software (along with the student instructions).

Students: Download the Installer

1. Log in to your MathWorks Account at mathworks.com that is associated with your university email address. If you don't have an account, create one using your university email address.
2. Click on your profile name in the upper right hand corner and select **Associate License**.
3. Enter the **Activation Key** that your administrator gave you.
4. Click "**Download your products now**" or go to mathworks.com/downloads
5. Click the **download** button for the current release.
6. Choose a supported platform and download the installer.

Total Academic Headcount Student License Quick Start

Students: Install and Activate

1. Run the **installer**.
2. In the installer, select **Log in with a MathWorks Account** and follow the online instructions.
3. When prompted to do so, select the **Academic – Total Headcount** license labeled **Student**.
4. Select the products you want to download and install.
5. After downloading and installing your products, keep the **Activate MATLAB** checkbox selected and click **Next**.
6. When asked to provide a user name, verify that the displayed user name is correct. Continue with the process until activation is complete.
